

Letter of Intent
between
The Tokyo Metropolitan Government and Kuala Lumpur City Hall

The Tokyo Metropolitan Government and Kuala Lumpur City Hall, endeavoring to strengthen and further deepen the cooperative relations built to date and to make this relationship beneficial to the residents of both cities, have agreed to engage in practical exchange and cooperation in the following areas.

1. Matters concerning the development of urban infrastructure and countermeasures for aging infrastructure.
2. Matters concerning urban environmental measures, including climate change response measures.
3. Matters concerning the technological challenges of cities.

Both cities designate the International Affairs Division, Office of the Governor for Policy Planning, Tokyo Metropolitan Government, and International Relations Unit, Corporate Planning Department, Kuala Lumpur City Hall, in exercising its function and powers as a local authority, as the departments responsible for facilitating execution of this Letter of Intent, and shall endeavor to steadily promote exchange and cooperation in these agreed areas.

The aforementioned responsible departments shall provide support to their city's departments charged with implementing policies in each of the areas covered by this Letter of Intent.

This Letter of Intent has been made in duplicate in both Japanese and English, both equally authentic. Both cities shall hold one copy of each text.
